Participation in the Erasmus+ program

Our operational objectives for the coming years are:

- 3. To maintain student mobilities for FCT internships and strengthen those of post-graduates.
- 4. To maintain the mobility of both Higher Education and Vocational Training personnel.
- 5. To begin to carry out teachers' international mobilities.
- 6. To improve and enlarge our network of partners and collaborators.
- 7. To participate as partners in COVE projects
- 8. To apply for projects in consortium with other institutions
- 9. To maintain and renew, when necessary, our Erasmus+ commission.
